- Continued to support 2018 Summer STEAM Academic Enrichment Program (SAEP) - a 24/7, six week residential program on the campus of the California Maritime Academy, providing science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics – "STEAM studies" -- to Oakland multiethnic and gender equity high school students for early college preparation
- 2. Completed the maritime course at McClymond's High School. Guest speakers from AMNAV, Foss and Blue & Gold ferries had participated in the program in its bimonthly sessions. Initial feedback from program administrators was positive. SFBP and Oakland Unified School District plan to discuss the future of the program and vision direction in the fall
- 3. Continued outreach efforts to identify and encourage women and underrepresented mariners serving in command positions in industry planning to take future selection examinations for BOPC pilot trainee training program
- 4. Continued financial support for CMA "SFBP Pioneer Scholarships" to encourage qualified minority and female students
- 5. Sponsoring table at the San Francisco Maritime National Park Association Maritime Heritage Awards to honor women who shattered barriers in the maritime industry; invited local female mariners and cadets to attend as SFBP's guests
