- Attended Women in Maritime Leadership Conference March 9 11, 2017; participated in panel discussion and presentation on diversity in the workplace, outreach programs and career paths (joint presentation with Conoco Phillips/Polar Tankers, Chevron, G&H Towing, and Cox, Wooton)
- 2. Met with Port of Oakland (Amy Tharpe, Director of Social Responsibility and Laura Arreola, Community Investments Manager) and Tom Scott and Howard Jackson of the CMA SAEP/Stem program regarding shared interest in reaching the youth of the Oakland schools; exploring possible role for SFBP/pilots (including pilots as guest lecturers/mentors) for maritime club concept at McClymond's High School in West Oakland, and possible Port support for SAEP program
